**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 343 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 343 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 343 would amend existing law concerning tanning facilities to remove the requirement that a tanning device not exceed 100 degrees Fahrenheit. The bill would also make a technical correction to cite a federal regulation.

According to the Kansas State Board of Cosmetology, passage of SB 343 would have no fiscal effect.
