SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 382 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 382 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, wrecking or towing services must file certain notices, publications and affidavits with the county clerk prior to the sale of any abandoned or disabled vehicle. SB 382 would eliminate this requirement.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that the bill could reduce the workload of counties as a result of no longer being required to collect and process the notices, publications and affidavits. However, the precise fiscal effect for counties is unknown.

According to the Department of Revenue, the fiscal effect for the agency would be negligible and absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 382 is not reflected in *The FY 2017 Governor's Budget Report*.
