**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 386 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 386 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 386 would require the Secretary of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) to identify goals and develop plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes in Kansas, improve diabetes care, and control complications associated with diabetes. The bill would require KDHE to submit a report by January 10 of even-numbered years to the Legislative Coordinating Council that describes diabetes prevention and control programs at KDHE. The report would include the following:

1. The financial burden of diabetes on the state and localities;
2. The number of people impacted by KDHE programs;
3. An assessment of the benefits of diabetes control and prevention programs;
4. The amount and source of funding appropriated by the Legislature for diabetes programs and activities;
5. A description of the level of coordination among KDHE diabetes prevention and control program activities;
6. A summary of detailed action plans for controlling diabetes; and,
7. A detailed budget identifying anticipated costs of and resources necessary for the implementation of the action plans.

Passage of SB 386 would have no fiscal effect.
