SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 481 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 481 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Currently, the Kansas Sexually Violent Predator Act requires 2,000 feet between any transitional or conditional release facility or building for sexually violent predators and any licensed child care facility; any established place of worship; any residence in which a child under 18 years of age resides; or the real property of any school or building used by a unified school district or an accredited nonpublic school for student instruction or extracurricular activities.

SB 481 would reduce the distance requirement to one-quarter mile and strike the language applying the requirement to any residence in which a child under 18 years of age resides.
