1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;
2 providing for the omega psi phi license plate.
3

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2016, any owner or lessee of
6 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
7 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
8 the provisions of this section, may be issued one omega psi phi license
9 plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be
10 issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper registration
11 and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and
12 amendments thereto, and either the payment to the county treasurer of the
13 logo use royalty payment established by omega psi phi or the presentation
14 of the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection
15 (b).

16 (b) Omega psi phi may authorize the use of their logo to be affixed on
17 license plates as provided by this section. Any royalty payment received
18 pursuant to this section shall be used to support omega psi phi. Any motor
19 vehicle owner or lessee annually may apply to omega psi phi for the use of
20 such logo. Upon annual application and payment to either: (1) Omega psi
21 phi in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 as a logo use
22 royalty payment for each license plate to be issued, omega psi phi shall
23 issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo
24 use authorization statement, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle
25 owner or lessee at the time of registration; or (2) the county treasurer of
26 the logo use royalty payment for each license plate to be issued.

27 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
28 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
29 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
30 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall
31 either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
32 subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment
33 established by omega psi phi. Application for registration of a passenger
34 vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be
35 made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of
36 vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

1 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
2 transferable to any other person.

3 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer the omega psi phi license
4 plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

5 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually,
6 upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the manner
7 prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No renewal of
8 registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant either
9 provides to the county treasurer either the annual logo use authorization
10 statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of the logo use
11 royalty payment as established by omega psi phi. If such logo use
12 authorization statement is not presented at the time of registration or faxed
13 by omega psi phi, or the annual logo use royalty payment is not made to
14 the county treasurer at the time of registration, the applicant shall be
15 required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return
16 the license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

17 (g) Omega psi phi shall:

18 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized
19 by this section; and

20 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
21 where applicants can call omega psi phi for information concerning the
22 application process or the status of their license plate application.

23 (h) Omega psi phi, with the approval of the director of vehicles and
24 subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall design a plate
25 to be issued under the provisions of this section.

26 (i) As a condition of receiving the omega psi phi license plate and any
27 subsequent registration renewal of such plate, the applicant must provide
28 consent to the division authorizing the division's release of motor vehicle
29 record information, including the applicant's name, address, logo use
30 royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to omega psi phi
31 and the state treasurer.

32 (j) Annual logo use royalty payments collected by county treasurers
33 under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance
34 with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon
35 receipt of each such remittance the state treasurer shall deposit the entire
36 amount in the state treasury to the credit of the omega psi phi royalty fund,
37 which is hereby created in the state treasury and shall be administered by
38 the state treasurer. All expenditures from the omega psi phi royalty fund
39 shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the
40 director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by
41 the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the
42 omega psi phi royalty fund to the appropriate designee of omega psi phi
43 shall be made on a monthly basis.

1 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
2 publication in the statute book.
