

**HOUSE BILL No. 2013**

1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;  
2 providing for the omega psi phi license plate.

3  
4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2016, any owner or lessee of  
6 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of  
7 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with  
8 the provisions of this section, may be issued one omega psi phi license  
9 plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates shall be  
10 issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper registration  
11 and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and  
12 amendments thereto, and either the payment to the county treasurer of the  
13 logo use royalty payment established by omega psi phi or the presentation  
14 of the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection  
15 (b).

16 (b) Omega psi phi may authorize the use of ~~their~~ *its* logo to be affixed  
17 on license plates as provided by this section. Any royalty payment  
18 received pursuant to this section shall be used to support omega psi phi.  
19 Any motor vehicle owner or lessee annually may apply to omega psi phi  
20 for the use of such logo. Upon annual application and payment to either:  
21 (1) Omega psi phi in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 as  
22 a logo use royalty payment for each license plate to be issued, omega psi  
23 phi shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge,  
24 a logo use authorization statement, which shall be presented by the motor  
25 vehicle owner or lessee at the time of registration; or (2) the county  
26 treasurer of the logo use royalty payment for each license plate to be  
27 issued.

28 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may  
29 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such  
30 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished  
31 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall  
32 either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in  
33 subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment  
34 established by omega psi phi. Application for registration of a passenger  
35 vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be  
36 made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of

1 vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

2 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be  
3 transferable to any other person.

4 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer the omega psi phi license  
5 plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

6 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually,  
7 upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the manner  
8 prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No renewal of  
9 registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant either  
10 provides to the county treasurer either the annual logo use authorization  
11 statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of the logo use  
12 royalty payment as established by omega psi phi. If such logo use  
13 authorization statement is not presented at the time of registration or faxed  
14 by omega psi phi, or the annual logo use royalty payment is not made to  
15 the county treasurer at the time of registration, the applicant shall be  
16 required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return  
17 the license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

18 (g) Omega psi phi shall:

19 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized  
20 by this section; and

21 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number  
22 where applicants can call omega psi phi for information concerning the  
23 application process or the status of their license plate application.

24 (h) Omega psi phi, with the approval of the director of vehicles and  
25 subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall design a plate  
26 to be issued under the provisions of this section.

27 (i) As a condition of receiving the omega psi phi license plate and any  
28 subsequent registration renewal of such plate, the applicant must provide  
29 consent to the division authorizing the division's release of motor vehicle  
30 record information, including the applicant's name, address, logo use  
31 royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to omega psi phi  
32 and the state treasurer.

33 (j) Annual logo use royalty payments collected by county treasurers  
34 under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance  
35 with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon  
36 receipt of each such remittance the state treasurer shall deposit the entire  
37 amount in the state treasury to the credit of the omega psi phi royalty fund,  
38 which is hereby created in the state treasury and shall be administered by  
39 the state treasurer. All expenditures from the omega psi phi royalty fund  
40 shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the  
41 director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by  
42 the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the  
43 omega psi phi royalty fund to the appropriate designee of omega psi phi

1 shall be made on a monthly basis.

2       Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

3 publication in the statute book.
