HOUSE BILL No. 2032

1 AN ACT relating to diabetes information reporting.

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3 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

4 Section 1. (a) The secretary of health and environment shall identify
5 goals and benchmarks and develop plans to reduce the incidence of
6 diabetes in Kansas, improve diabetes care and control complications
7 associated with diabetes.

8 (b) The secretary ~~shall~~ **may** submit a report to the legislative
9 coordinating council by January 10 of each even-numbered year on the
10 following:

11 (1) The financial impact and reach diabetes is having on the
12 department of health and environment, the state of Kansas and localities
13 within the state, including the number of individuals with diabetes
14 impacted or covered by programs administered by the secretary, the
15 number of individuals with diabetes and family members impacted by
16 prevention and diabetes control programs implemented by the department,
17 if any, the financial toll or impact diabetes and its complications places on
18 the department and the financial toll or impact diabetes and its
19 complications places on the department in comparison to other chronic
20 diseases and conditions;

21 (2) an assessment of the benefits of implemented programs and
22 activities aimed at controlling diabetes and preventing the disease shall
23 include documenting the amount and source for any funding directed to
24 the department from the Kansas legislature for programs and activities
25 aimed at reaching those with diabetes;

26 (3) a description of the level of coordination existing in the
27 department, programmatic activities and messaging concerning managing,
28 treating or preventing all forms of diabetes and its complications;

29 (4) the development or revision of detailed action plans for battling
30 diabetes with a range of actionable items for consideration by the
31 legislature, which shall identify proposed action steps to reduce the impact
32 of diabetes, pre-diabetes and related diabetes complications and identify
33 the expected benchmarks for controlling and preventing relevant forms of
34 diabetes; and

35 (5) the development of a detailed budget blueprint identifying needs,
36 costs and resources required to implement the plan identified in subsection

1 (4), which blueprint shall include a budget range for all options presented
2 in the plan identified in subsection (4) for consideration by the legislature.

3 (c) The requirements of this section, and amendments thereto, shall
4 be limited to the diabetes information, data, initiatives and programs
5 within the department prior to the effective date of this act, unless there is
6 unobligated funding for diabetes in the department that may be used for
7 new research, data collection, reporting or other requirements of this
8 section, and amendments thereto.

9 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
10 publication in the statute book.
