1 AN ACT concerning certain improvement districts; amending K.S.A. 19-
2 2761 and repealing the existing section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 19-2761 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-
6 2761. ~~That should~~ (a) *Except as provided in subsection (b), when a*
7 *vacancy—occur occurs* at any time in the office of a director of any
8 improvement district, the remaining directors shall appoint *a person* from
9 the qualified residents in such district ~~a person~~ to hold the office of
10 director until the next election.

11 (b) (1) *When a vacancy occurs in the office of a director of the Peck*
12 *improvement district located in Sumner and Sedgwick counties, the board*
13 *of county commissioners of Sumner county shall appoint a resident of*
14 *Sumner county or Sedgwick county to hold the office of director until the*
15 *next election.*

16 (2) **Once the appointment of a director has been made under**
17 **paragraph (1), the Sedgwick county board of commissioners shall**
18 **have 30 days to reject such appointment by a majority vote of the**
19 **board. If no such action is taken, the appointment shall be deemed**
20 **approved. If the appointment is rejected, the appointment process**
21 **shall be repeated until a director is selected.**

22 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 19-2761 is hereby repealed.

23 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
24 publication in the Kansas register.
