Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 22-2619 is hereby amended to read as Section 1. 8 follows: 22-2619. (a) "Crime committed with an electronic device" means 9 the commission of any crime that involves or is facilitated by the use of 10 any electronic device-, including, but not limited to, all violations of the 11 following are crimes committed with an electronic device: Criminal use of 12 a financial card, as defined in K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 21-5828, and 13 amendments thereto; unlawful acts concerning computers, as defined in K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 21-5839, and amendments thereto; identity theft and 14 identity fraud, as defined in K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 21-6107, and amendments 15 16 thereto; and electronic solicitation, as defined in K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 21-5509, and amendments thereto. 17

- (b) In addition to the venue provided for under any other provision of law, a prosecution for any crime committed with an electronic device may be brought in the county in which:
- (1) Any requisite act to the commission of the crime occurred;
- 22 (2) the victim resides;
  - (3) the victim was present at the time of the crime; or
  - (4) property affected by the crime was obtained or was attempted to be obtained.
  - (c) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the Kansas code for criminal procedure.
  - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 22-2619 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
