

**HOUSE BILL No. 2509**

1 AN ACT concerning state agencies, relating to the office of information  
2 technology services, executive chief information technology officer;  
3 concerning agency budgets for information technology security;  
4 amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 75-7205 and repealing the existing  
5 section.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 New Section 1. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, all  
9 executive branch state agencies shall be required to receive approval from  
10 the executive chief information technology officer for all expenditures for  
11 information technology by the agency. Such agencies shall annually  
12 submit a three-year information technology management and budget plan  
13 pursuant to K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 75-7209, and amendments thereto, that  
14 includes planned expenses for information technology. The executive chief  
15 information technology officer shall review, coordinate and approve  
16 information technology expenses for all such agencies. The head of each  
17 state agency shall provide information to and cooperate with the executive  
18 chief information technology officer for the purposes of implementing and  
19 administering this section and the policies and procedures prescribed by  
20 the executive chief information technology officer.

21 (b) The executive chief information technology officer shall annually  
22 present the integrated proposed information technology budget for  
23 executive branch agencies to the senate committee on ways and means, the  
24 house committee on appropriations and the joint committee on information  
25 technology.

26 (c) The executive chief information technology officer shall develop  
27 and adopt policies and procedures for reviewing and approving the  
28 information technology expenses of all executive branch state agencies.

29 (d) The executive chief information technology officer may delegate  
30 authority to any state agency to approve any information technology  
31 expenses under conditions and procedures prescribed by the chief  
32 information technology officer in accordance with this section.

33 (e) The executive chief information technology officer shall direct the  
34 executive chief information security officer to review the: (1) Appropriate  
35 information technology structure for ensuring information technology  
36 security within state agencies;

1 (2) security between local governmental entities and state agencies  
2 and between state agencies and private vendors;

3 (3) training programs for state employees regarding cyber security;

4 (4) existing assistance programs for local governmental entities that  
5 interact with state agencies;

6 (5) compliance monitoring for state agencies regarding cyber  
7 security; and

8 (6) any other relevant information technology security issues as  
9 determined by the executive chief information technology officer.

10 (f) The executive chief information technology officer shall be  
11 invited to speak before every standing legislative committee at the  
12 beginning of the 2017 regular legislative session.

13 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 75-7205 is hereby amended to read as  
14 follows: 75-7205. (a) There is hereby established within and as a part of  
15 the office of information technology services the position of executive  
16 chief information technology officer. The executive chief information  
17 technology officer shall be in the unclassified service under the Kansas  
18 civil service act, shall be appointed by the governor, and shall receive  
19 compensation in an amount fixed by the governor. The executive chief  
20 information technology officer shall maintain a presence in any cabinet  
21 established by the governor and shall report to the governor.

22 (b) The executive chief information technology officer shall:

23 (1) Review and consult with each executive agency regarding  
24 information technology plans, deviations from the state information  
25 technology architecture, information technology project estimates and  
26 information technology project changes and overruns submitted by such  
27 agency pursuant to K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 75-7209, and amendments thereto,  
28 to determine whether the agency has complied with: (A) The information  
29 technology resource policies and procedures and project management  
30 methodologies adopted by the information technology executive council;  
31 (B) the information technology architecture adopted by the information  
32 technology executive council; (C) the standards for data management  
33 adopted by the information technology executive council; and (D) the  
34 strategic information technology management plan adopted by the  
35 information technology executive council;

7 management adopted by the information technology executive council;  
8 ~~and~~ (D) the strategic information technology management plan adopted by  
9 the information technology executive council; *and (E) the standards for*  
10 *information security adopted by the information technology executive*  
11 *council;*

12 ~~(5)~~ (4) coordinate implementation of new information technology  
13 among executive agencies and with the judicial and legislative chief  
14 information technology officers;

15 ~~(6)~~ (5) designate the ownership of information resource processes and  
16 the lead agency for implementation of new technologies and networks  
17 shared by multiple agencies within the executive branch of state  
18 government; ~~and~~

19 (6) *review, coordinate and approve all appropriate information*  
20 *technology expenditures for all executive branch state agencies pursuant*  
21 *to section 1, and amendments thereto;*

22 (7) *review and restructure, as necessary, current information*  
23 *technology security responsibilities for all executive branch state agencies*  
24 *pursuant to section 1, and amendments thereto;*

25 (8) *evaluate how to coordinate information technology security*  
26 *interests between institutions governed by the regents and other state*  
27 *agencies; and*

28 ~~(7)~~ (9) perform such other functions and duties as provided by law or  
29 as directed by the governor.

30 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 75-7205 is hereby repealed.
