1 AN ACT concerning schools; relating to the Kansas state high school
2 activities association; relating to participation by certain students.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) Any student who: (1) Is a resident of a school district;
6 (2) attends a school registered with the state board of education in
7 accordance with K.S.A. 72-53,101, and amendments thereto, and such
8 school attests to the student's compliance with all applicable academic
9 requirements for participation in activities offered by such school district;
10 (3) submits an immunization record to such school district in accordance
11 with K.S.A. 72-5209, and amendments thereto; and (4) submits proof of
12 health insurance if required by the board of education of such school
13 district, shall be permitted to participate in any activities offered by such
14 school district regardless of whether such student attends a school in such
15 school district on a full-time basis.

16 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to permit a student to
17 participate in an activity if such student is otherwise prohibited from
18 participating for any reason other than attendance, or if such student is
19 prohibited from participating because of truancy.

20 (c) Any student participating in high school activities shall be subject
21 to the age and eligibility requirements of the association, as described in
22 K.S.A. 72-130, and amendments thereto, that are not in conflict with the
23 provisions of this section.

24 (d) To the extent any participation fees are required to be paid by a
25 student participating in an activity, the same fees shall be paid by any
26 student participating in such activity despite not attending a school in such
27 school district on a full-time basis.

28 (e) Any liability insurance obtained by a school district that provides
29 coverage of students participating in activities offered by such school
30 district shall also cover any student who participates in such activities
31 despite not attending a school in such school district on a full-time basis.

32 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
33 publication in the statute book.
