1 AN ACT designating a portion of K-96 as the George Ablah expressway;
2 amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 68-10,106 and repealing the existing
3 section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. The portion of K-96 highway from the junction with
7 interstate highway 135 then east to the junction with Rock Road in
8 Sedgwick county is hereby designated as the George Ablah expressway.
9 The secretary of transportation shall place markers along the highway
10 right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the George
11 Ablah expressway, except that such signs shall not be placed until the
12 secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to
13 reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional
14 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs
15 of such signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer
16 gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

17 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 68-10,106 is hereby amended to read as
18 follows: 68-10,106. The portion of K-96 highway from the junction with
19 ~~interstate highway 135~~ *Rock Road in Sedgwick county* then east to the
20 junction with interstate highway 35 is hereby designated as the Bonnie
21 Huy memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place
22 markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that
23 the highway is the Bonnie Huy memorial highway, except that such signs
24 shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from
25 gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such
26 signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance
27 or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may
28 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing
29 suitable signs.

30 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 68-10,106 is hereby repealed.

31 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
32 publication in the statute book.
