SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 404

As Recommended by Senate Committee on
Ways and Means

Brief*

SB 404 would allow the State Board of Regents, on behalf of Kansas State University, to sell and convey specified real estate located in Riley County, Kansas.

Background

The Head of the Agronomy Department at Kansas State University testified as a proponent of the bill, noting there is a discrepancy between the legal description and the fence lines of the property in an area known as Ashland Bottoms. Westar Energy discovered the discrepancy while working to lay electrical line on the property.

The Committee recommended the bill be placed on the Consent Calendar.

The Division of the Budget fiscal note stated an appraisal of the property has been completed, but the amount that may be realized from the potential sale of the property is currently unknown.
