DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION

(t) During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, in addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made from the state general fund or any special revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2018 by the above agency by this or other appropriation act of the 2017 regular session of the legislature, expenditures shall be made by the above agency from the state general fund or any special revenue fund or funds to form a task force to study, review and develop a plan for the: (1) Procurement of information technology equipment, services and software; food; office supplies; furniture and fixtures; fuel; and any other purchased durable goods to achieve the most cost-efficiencies for school districts; (2) implementation and administration of a unified school district employee health care benefits program; and (3) identification of any other school district efficiencies: *Provided*, That the task force members shall include a representative from the Wichita public school district, a representative from a rural school district as appointed by the secretary of administration, two legislators appointed by majority leader of the house of representatives, a legislator appointed by minority leader of the house of representatives, and any additional stakeholders as deemed necessary by the secretary of administration: *Provided further*, That upon request by the task force, any existing or previously convened working group that studied such issues shall report to and advise the task force: *And provided further*, That such task force shall provide a report to the house appropriations committee and the senate ways and means committee on or before January 8, 2018, detailing the findings of such study, including a plan to implement the findings of the task force.
