Subject:

HB 2050

HB 2050 recreates the joint committee on economic development. The bill provides for an effective date upon publication in the Kansas register.

Jurisdiction:

Includes oversight over all economic development agencies, programs and functions of the state.

May introduce legislation.

LCC may provide for professional services for the committee upon request.

The membership:

Five Senators:

Chairperson of the Committee on Commerce (or appointee from that committee);

Two other members of the Committee on Commerce appointed by the Senate President;

Ranking Minority Member of the Committee on Commerce (or appointee from that committee);

One member of Committee on Commerce appointed by the Minority Leader.

Eight Representatives:

Chairperson of the Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development (or appointee from that committee);

Four members of that committee appointed by the Speaker;
Ranking Minority Member of that committee (or appointee from that committee);
Two members of that committee appointed by the Minority Leader.

Terms and Organization:

First organizational session shall occur within 30 days after July 1, 2017.

First Chairperson elected shall be a Representative

First Vice-chairperson elected shall be a Senator.

Both serve through June 30, 2018.

publication in the kanses register

After July 1, 2018 and until first day of 2019 legislative session, Chairperson shall be Senator and Vice-chairperson shall be Representative

Thereafter, switches every year.

All terms end on first day of the legislative session in odd-numbered years.

Meetings:

At any time and at any place within state upon call of Chairperson Reimbursement for members
