My name is Colleen McDermott. I am the campus President for Concorde Career College in Kansas City, Missouri. I would like to thank the committee for the opportunity to submit testimony in support of House Bill 2139.

As an institution focused on health care education, I am in support of the dental therapist model for multiple reasons. Dental Hygiene is offered at our Kansas City campus, and expanding the provider model would create a career ladder for our graduates; bringing more high paying jobs to the state. This expansion would also create jobs by bringing faculty and students from out of state.
