Chairman Vickrey and Members of the House Insurance Committee:

The Kansas Association of Professional Insurance Agents, Inc., (PIA) appreciates the opportunity to submit written testimony in support of HB 2104 which proposes to increase the minimum bodily injury limit on motorist insurance policies from \$25,000/\$50,000 to \$50,000/\$100,000, and would prohibit an insurer from reducing the amount of underinsured motorist coverage available for a claim by any payment amount paid by anyone other than the insurer. As you know, the Kansas PIA is an affiliate of the National Association of Professional Insurance Agents (PIA National).
