HB2614 — Providing a child tax credit.

To the respected members of the House Tax Committee,

HB 2614 would provide an income tax credit of \$200 for each qualifying child of the taxpayer beginning in tax year 2018. The bill includes the definition for a qualifying child. The bill requires any taxpayer claiming the credit to provide a valid Social Security number.

The cost of this would be \$81,200,000 per year and could be paid for with 2661 or 2618.
