There are currently 45 Microbrewery and Package Warehouse Facility Licenses in Kansas. There is an ABC created map attached to this testimony.

There have been growlers since the beginning of Microbreweries in Kansas. There is even language in the statutes and regs addressing how they are taxed. We thank the ABC for bringing clear language for the actual practice.

The microbrewery language was originally HB 2475 and was amended in whole into HB 2476 by the House committee.


