Re: HOUSE BILL No. 2130

Section 1 of HB 2130 would remove the requirement that copies of all contracts extending more than one year be filed with the Director of Accounts and Reports. It would also remove the requirement to use forms prescribed by the director of accounts and reports when a purchase order is required for each payment against a contract.

Section 2(a) removes the requirement that contracts receive a countersignature of the Director of Accounts and Reports. Section 2(b) removes the requirement that contracts show on their face that an appropriation or allotment has been encumbered for the full amount of the liability.

This bill would take effect upon publication in the statute book.
