 Subject: Sub for HB 2332 – Revisions to the membership of the information technology executive council.

Substitute for HB 2332 amends K.S.A. 75-7202 to change the number of voting members of the information technology executive council (ITEC) from 17 to 15, and amends its membership as reflected below. Subsection (d) is amended to require ITEC to hold quarterly meetings.
