SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2243 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2243 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2243 would allow mechanical restraints to be used by school security officers when the use of the device complies with local board policies and when significant physical harm to the student or others would occur if a mechanical restraint is not utilized. The bill would require all schools to maintain documentation on all personnel receiving required training on mechanical restraints.

Enactment of HB 2243 would have no fiscal effect on state aid to school districts. Any costs incurred to implement provisions of HB 2243 would be borne by local school districts.
