**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2258 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2258 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2258 would prohibit a court from requiring a psychiatric or psychological examination of a witness who is an alleged victim of a crime categorized as a sex offense, selling sexual relations, promoting the sale of sexual relations, buying sexual relations, commercial sexual exploitation of a child, human trafficking or aggravated human trafficking, and incest or aggravated incest.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates that any fiscal effect which may result with the enactment of HB 2258 would be negligible.
