SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2263 by House Committee on Corrections and
Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2263 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the Secretary of Corrections is authorized to sell products and services to the federal government, any state agency, state employees for their personal use, any local agency or organization within the state, and to the extent not prohibited by federal law, to other states. HB 2263 would authorize the Secretary of Corrections to sell products and services to contractors or vendors of government entities.

The Department of Corrections indicates that HB 2263 would increase revenue to Kansas Correctional Industries; however, the Department cannot estimate how much additional revenue would be generated. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2263 is not reflected in *The FY 2018 Governor's Budget Report*.
