SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2265 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2265 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2265 would amend the definition of “federal law enforcement officer” by eliminating the requirement that the person be assigned to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The bill would also add “federal law enforcement officers” as defined in current law to the definition of “police officer” and “law enforcement officer.”

According to the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers’ Standards and Training, enactment of HB 2265 would have no fiscal effect.
