SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2297 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2297 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2297 would require that the clinical instructions and demonstration of skills in nurse aide training must be performed in the following settings that offer the full range of clinical tasks and experiences: adult care homes; a long-term care unit of a hospital; a simulated laboratory; or a professional healthcare association approved by the Secretary for the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services. The bill would prohibit an adult care home from sponsoring or providing clinical instruction for a nurse aide course if that adult care home has been subject to any sanctions under federal regulation for long-term facilities.

The passage of HB 2297 would have no fiscal effect on the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services.
