SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2393 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2393 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2393 would abolish the Hazmat Fee Fund and hazardous material endorsement fees on commercial drivers' licenses. The bill would require the Director of Accounts and Reports to transfer all monies in the Hazmat Fee Fund to the State General Fund on the effective date of the bill.

According to the Kansas Department of Revenue, enactment of HB 2393 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations because the Department indicates it has not received hazardous material endorsement fees in recent years.
