SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2483 by Representative Aurand

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2483 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2483 would expand the definition of a teacher to include any professional employee who holds a certificate to teach in any school district and who has been continuously employed as a teacher by the same school district since July 1, 2014. The bill would extend “due process” for teachers who have been employed since June 30, 2014. The bill would specifically exclude any person employed in an administrative capacity by any technical college, community college, the Institute of Technology at Washburn University, or any supervisors, principals, or superintendents. In addition, the provisions would not apply to any teacher that has committed a felony or similar offense.

According to the Department of Education, enactment of HB 2483 would have no fiscal effect.
