In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 106 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 106 would prevent an officer, director or employee of any business that has entered into a contract with the state to provide services for the KanCare program from making any campaign contribution to any member of the Robert G. Bethel Joint Committee on Home and Community Based Services and KanCare Oversight.

According to the Governmental Ethics Commission, passage of SB 106 would have no fiscal effect.
