SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 114 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 114 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 114 would amend the Revised Kansas Code for Care of Children to make an alcohol or drug test report admissible as evidence if the report is prepared by a person or facility that conducted the test. The bill also requires a certificate signed under oath from this person attesting to the result and analysis of the test.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates SB 114 would have no fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations.
