SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 322 by Senate Committee on Utilities

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 322 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 322 would amend the Net Metering and Easy Connection Act to require that utilities offer a tariff or contract to a customer-generator identical to that which would be assigned to a customer that is not a customer-generator, with no additional standby, capacity, interconnection or other fee or charge. According to the bill, any net excess generation credit remaining in a net-metering customer's account at the end of a calendar year would expire. The bill would also make a number of technical corrections to the Act.

According to the Kansas Corporation Commission, enactment of SB 322 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
