SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 40 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 40 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, a person can be arrested by means of an arrest warrant for violating the conditions of an appearance bond. SB 40 would authorize any pretrial services supervision officer to perform an arrest for a bond revocation, or deputize any other qualified officer to perform the arrest, without a warrant. The supervision officer would be required to provide a statement addressing the defendant's violation of the bond conditions to the arresting officer and the detaining authorities.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates any fiscal effect on expenditures by the Judicial Branch that may result from the enactment of SB 40 would be negligible.
