SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 52 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 52 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 52 would amend the state's Uniform Controlled Substances Act by adding and updating drugs contained in Schedules II and V to match federal schedules. The bill would also add the following drugs to the list of drugs and substances in Schedule 1: AH-7921, Beta-hydroxythiofentanyl, Furanyl fentanyl, O-desmethyltramadol and other trade names, U-47700, Alpha-ethyltryptamine 7249 and other trade names, Etizolam and other trade names, Aminorex 1585 and other trade names, Thiafentanil, Brivaracetam and other trade names.

The passage of SB 52 would have no fiscal effect for the Board of Pharmacy.
