1 AN ACT concerning treatment facilities; relating to license renewal;
2 amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 65-4014 and repealing the existing
3 section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 65-4014 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 65-4014. (a) The secretary shall issue a license if the applicant
8 meets the minimum requirements established by or pursuant to this act for
9 a treatment facility. Each license shall be issued only for the premises and
10 persons or governmental units named in the application and shall not be
11 transferable or assignable except with the written approval of the secretary.
12 Licenses shall be posted in a conspicuous place on the licensed premises.

13 (b) (1) The secretary may renew a license at the end of one, two or
14 three years depending upon a facility's level of compliance with the rules
15 and regulations adopted by the secretary pursuant to K.S.A. 65-4016, and
16 amendments thereto.

17 (2) *Programs and treatments provided by a treatment facility that*
18 *have been licensed by the secretary for aging and disability services*~~*on or*~~
19 ~~*before July 1, 2017,*~~ *and that have also been accredited by the commission*
20 *on accreditation of rehabilitation services, the joint commission or the*
21 *council on accreditation or another national accrediting body approved by*
22 *the Kansas department for aging and disability services shall be granted a*
23 *license based on such accreditation.*

24 (A) *The Kansas department for aging and disability services shall*
25 *inspect accredited treatment facilities to determine compliance with state*
26 *licensing standards and rules and regulations not covered by the*
27 *accrediting entity's standards. Treatment facilities receiving accreditation*
28 *shall continue to be subject to inspections and investigations from*
29 *complaints.*

30 (B) *In the event that an accredited treatment facility loses its*
31 *accreditation, the treatment facility shall immediately notify the Kansas*
32 *department for aging and disability services.*

33 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 65-4014 is hereby repealed.

34 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
35 publication in the statute book.
