

HOUSE BILL No. 2281

1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;
2 providing for the Kansas 4-H foundation license plate.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2018, any owner or lessee of
6 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
7 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
8 the provisions of this section, may be issued one Kansas 4-H foundation
9 license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plates
10 shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper
11 registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-
12 143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to the county
13 treasurer of the logo use royalty payment established by the Kansas 4-H
14 foundation, inc. or the presentation of the annual logo use authorization
15 statement provided for in subsection (b).

16 (b) The Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. may authorize the use of the
17 organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this
18 section. Any royalty payment received pursuant to this section shall be
19 used to support the Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. Any motor vehicle owner
20 or lessee annually may apply to the Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. for use of
21 such logo. Upon annual application and payment to either: (1) The Kansas
22 4-H foundation, inc. in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100
23 as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be issued, the
24 Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. shall issue to the motor vehicle owner or
25 lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization statement that shall
26 be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at the time of
27 registration; or (2) the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment for
28 each license plate to be issued.

29 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
30 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such
31 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
32 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall
33 either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
34 subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment
35 established by the Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. Application for registration
36 of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this

1 section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the
2 director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

3 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
4 transferable to any other person.

5 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer Kansas 4-H foundation
6 license plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

7 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually,
8 upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the manner
9 prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No renewal of
10 registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant provides to
11 the county treasurer either the annual logo use authorization statement
12 provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of the annual royalty
13 payment established by the Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. If such statement
14 is not presented at the time of registration or faxed by the Kansas 4-H
15 foundation, inc., or the annual royalty payment is not made to the county
16 treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the provisions of
17 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the
18 county treasurer of such person's residence.

19 (g) The Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. shall provide to all county
20 treasurers an electronic mail address where applicants can contact the
21 Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. for information concerning the application
22 process or the status of such applicant's license plate application.

23 (h) As a condition of receiving the Kansas 4-H foundation license
24 plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the
25 applicant must provide consent to the division authorizing the division's
26 release of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's
27 name, address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to
28 the Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. and the state treasurer.

29 (i) Annual royalty payments collected by county treasurers under this
30 section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the
31 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of
32 each such remittance the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in
33 the state treasury to the credit of the Kansas 4-H foundation royalty fund,
34 which is hereby created in the state treasury and shall be administered by
35 the state treasurer. All expenditures from the Kansas 4-H foundation
36 royalty fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon
37 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to
38 vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee.
39 Payments from the Kansas 4-H foundation royalty fund to the appropriate
40 designee of the Kansas 4-H foundation, inc. shall be made on a monthly
41 basis.

42 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
43 publication in the statute book.
