AN ACT concerning real estate appraisers; relating to appraisal practice standards; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 58-4121 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 58-4121 is hereby amended to read as follows: 58-4121. (a) When performing an appraisal of real property for a real estate-related financial transaction, a state certified or licensed appraiser shall comply with the 2014-2015 edition of the uniform standards of professional appraisal practice promulgated pursuant to federal law or and later versions as established in rules and regulations version as adopted by the board in rules and regulations.

- (b) When performing an appraisal of real property for any purpose other than a real estate-related financial transaction, a state certified or licensed appraiser shall comply with:
- (1) The 2014-2015 edition of the uniform standards of professional appraisal practice promulgated pursuant to federal law or any later version as adopted by the board in rules and regulations; or
- (2) the 2016 edition of the standards of valuation practice and valuers' code of professional ethics promulgated by the appraisal institute or any later version as adopted by the board in rules and regulations, except that a state certified or licensed appraiser shall not accept a fee for an appraisal assignment that is contingent upon the appraiser reporting a predetermined estimate, analysis or opinion, upon the opinion, conclusion or valuation reached, or upon the consequences resulting from the appraisal assignment.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state certified or licensed appraiser who performs an evaluation of real property for a real estate-related financial transaction that is regulated by a federal financial institutions regulatory agency shall only be required to comply with the interagency appraisal and evaluation guidelines promulgated by the federal financial institutions regulatory agency as of July 1, 2017.
  - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 58-4121 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
