1 AN ACT concerning certain claims against the state, making
2 appropriations, authorizing certain transfers, imposing certain
3 restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain
4 disbursements, procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, appropriations
8 are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and
9 transfers, disbursements, procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing
10 are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

7 **(a) On the effective date of this act, the expenditure limitation**
 8 **established for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, by the state**
 9 **finance council by section 177(d) of chapter 104 of the 2017 Session**
 10 **Laws of Kansas on the Kansas highway patrol operations fund (280-**
 11 **00-2034-1100) of the Kansas highway patrol is hereby increased from**
 12 **\$52,236,578 to \$52,248,411.60.**

13 **(b) On the effective date of this act, the amount of \$12,998,317.75**
 14 **authorized by section 144(d) of chapter 104 of the 2017 Session Laws**
 15 **of Kansas to be transferred by the director of accounts and reports**
 16 **from the state highway fund of the department of transportation to**
 17 **the Kansas highway patrol operations fund (280-00-2034-1100) of the**
 18 **Kansas highway patrol on April 1, 2018, is hereby increased to**
 19 **\$13,010,151.35.**

20 ~~Sec. 9-11.~~ **12.** (a) Except as otherwise provided by this act, the
 21 director of accounts and reports is hereby authorized and directed to draw
 22 warrants on the state treasurer in favor of the claimants specified in this
 23 act, upon vouchers duly executed by the state agencies directed to pay the
 24 amounts specified in such sections to the claimants or their legal
 25 representatives or duly authorized agents, as provided by law.

26 (b) The director of accounts and reports shall secure prior to the
 27 payment of any amount to any claimant, other than amounts authorized to
 28 be paid pursuant to section 4, as motor-vehicle fuel tax refunds or as
 29 transactions between state agencies as provided by this act, a written
 30 release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against the state of Kansas
 31 and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of Kansas regarding
 32 their respective claims.

33 ~~Sec. 10-12.~~ **13.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and
 34 after its publication in the Kansas register.
