1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;
2 providing for the special olympics Kansas ~~license plate and~~{,} **the**
3 **choose life license plate {and, the city of Wichita license plate},**
4 **Korean war, operation desert storm, operation Iraqi freedom and**
5 **operation enduring freedom license plates; amending K.S.A. 2017**
6 **Supp. 8-1,141 and 8-1,147 and repealing the existing ~~section~~**
7 **sections.**

8
9 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

10 **New Section 1.** (a) On and after January 1, 2019, any owner or lessee
11 of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight
12 of 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance
13 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one special olympics
14 Kansas license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license
15 plates shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper
16 registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-
17 143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to the county
18 treasurer of the logo use royalty payment established by special olympics
19 Kansas or the presentation of the annual logo use authorization statement
20 provided for in subsection (b).

21 (b) Special olympics Kansas may authorize the use of their logo to be
22 affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any royalty payment
23 received pursuant to this section shall be used to support special olympics
24 Kansas. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee annually may apply to special
25 olympics Kansas for the use of such logo. Upon annual application and
26 payment to either: (1) Special olympics Kansas in an amount of not less
27 than \$25 nor more than \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each
28 license plate to be issued, special olympics Kansas shall issue to the motor
29 vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization
30 statement, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee
31 at the time of registration; or (2) the county treasurer of the logo use
32 royalty payment for each license plate to be issued.

1 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
2 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such
3 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
4 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall
5 either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
6 subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment
7 established by special olympics Kansas. Application for registration of a
8 passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this
9 section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the
10 director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

11 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
12 transferable to any other person.

13 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer special olympics Kansas
14 license plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

15 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually,
16 upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the manner
17 prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No renewal of
18 registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant either
19 provides to the county treasurer the annual logo use authorization
20 statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of the logo use
21 royalty payment as established by special olympics Kansas. If such logo
22 use authorization statement is not presented at the time of registration or
23 faxed by special olympics Kansas, or the annual logo use royalty payment
24 is not made to the county treasurer at the time of registration, the applicant
25 shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto,
26 and return the license plate to the county treasurer of such person's
27 residence.

28 (g) Special olympics Kansas shall:

29 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized
30 by this section; and

31 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
32 where applicants can call special olympics Kansas for information
33 concerning the application process or the status of their license plate
34 application.

35 (h) Special olympics Kansas, with the approval of the director of
36 vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equipment, shall
37 design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

38 (i) As a condition of receiving the special olympics Kansas license
39 plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such plate, the applicant
40 must provide consent to the division authorizing the division's release of
41 motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name, address,
42 logo use royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to special
43 olympics Kansas and the state treasurer.

1 (j) Annual logo use royalty payments collected by county treasurers
2 under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance
3 with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon
4 receipt of each such remittance the state treasurer shall deposit the entire
5 amount in the state treasury to the credit of the special olympics Kansas
6 royalty fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury and shall be
7 administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures from the special
8 olympics Kansas royalty fund shall be made in accordance with
9 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports
10 issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state
11 treasurer's designee. Payments from the special olympics Kansas royalty
12 fund to the appropriate designee of special olympics Kansas shall be made
13 on a monthly basis.

14 **New Sec. 2. (a) On and after January 1, 2019, any owner or lessee**
15 **of one or more passenger vehicles, trucks of a gross weight of 20,000**
16 **pounds or less, motorcycles or travel trailers, who is a resident of the**
17 **state of Kansas, may apply for and be issued one distinctive license**
18 **plate for each such passenger vehicle, truck, motorcycle or travel**
19 **trailer, a choose life license plate. Such license plates shall be issued for**
20 **the same period of time as other plates upon proper registration and**
21 **payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and**
22 **amendments thereto.**

23 (b) Any person may make application for such distinctive license
24 plates, not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of
25 registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by the director
26 of vehicles. Application for the registration of a passenger vehicle,
27 truck, motorcycle or travel trailer and issuance of the license plates
28 under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner
29 prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the
30 director.

31 (c) No registration or distinctive license plate issued under the
32 authority of this section shall be transferable to any other person.

33 (d) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
34 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
35 manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No
36 renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such
37 applicant has filed with the director a form as provided in subsection
38 (b). If such form is not filed, the applicant shall be required to comply
39 with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the distinctive
40 license plates to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

41 (e) The choose life license plate shall have a background design,
42 an emblem or colors that designate the license plate as a choose life
43 license plate.

1 **Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 8-1,141 is hereby amended to read as**
2 **follows: 8-1,141. (a) Any new distinctive license plate authorized for**
3 **issuance on and after July 1, 1994, shall be subject to the personalized**
4 **license plate fee prescribed by ~~subsection (e) of K.S.A. 8-132(c), and~~**
5 **amendments thereto. This section shall not apply to any distinctive**
6 **license plate authorized prior to July 1, 1994.**

7 **(b) The director of vehicles shall not issue any new distinctive**
8 **license plate authorized for issuance on and after July 1, 1995, unless**
9 **there is a guarantee of an initial issuance of at least 500 license plates.**

10 **(c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to distinctive**
11 **license plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,145, or K.S.A.**
12 **2017 Supp. 8-177d, 8-1,163~~—of~~, 8-1,166, section 5, 6, 7 or 8, and**
13 **amendments thereto.**

14 **(d) The provisions of subsection (a), shall not apply to distinctive**
15 **license plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,146 or 8-1,148,**
16 **and amendments thereto, or K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 8-1,153, 8-1,158 or 8-**
17 **1,161, and amendments thereto.**

18 **(e) The provisions of subsection (f) shall not apply to distinctive**
19 **license plates issued under the provisions of K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 8-1,160**
20 **and section 2, and amendments thereto, except that the division shall**
21 **delay the manufacturing and issuance of such distinctive license plate**
22 **until the division has received not less than 1,000 orders for such plate,**
23 **including payment of the personalized license plate fee required under**
24 **subsection (a). Upon certification by the director of vehicles to the**
25 **director of accounts and reports that not less than 1,000 paid orders**
26 **for such plate have been received, the director of accounts and reports**
27 **shall transfer \$40,000 from the state highway fund to the distinctive**
28 **license plate fund.**

29 **(f) (1) Any person or organization sponsoring any distinctive**
30 **license plate authorized by the legislature on and after July 1, 2004,**
31 **shall submit to the division of vehicles a nonrefundable amount not to**
32 **exceed \$20,000, to defray the division's cost for developing such**
33 **distinctive license plate.**

34 **(2) All moneys received under this subsection shall be remitted by**
35 **the secretary of revenue to the state treasurer in accordance with the**
36 **provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt**
37 **of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire**
38 **amount in the state treasury to the credit of the distinctive license**
39 **plate fund which is hereby created in the state treasury. All moneys**
40 **credited to the distinctive license plate fund shall be used by the**
41 **department of revenue only for the purpose associated with the**
42 **development of distinctive license plates. All expenditures from the**
43 **distinctive license plate application fee fund shall be made in**

1 accordance with appropriation acts, upon warrants of the director of
2 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the
3 secretary of the department of revenue.

4 (g) (1) Except for educational institution license plates issued
5 under K.S.A. 8-1,142, and amendments thereto, the director of
6 vehicles shall discontinue the issuance of any distinctive license plate
7 authorized prior to July 1, 2004, and which is subject to the provisions
8 of subsection (b) if:

9 (A) Less than 500 license plates, including annual renewals, are
10 issued for that distinctive license plate by July 1, 2006; and

11 (B) less than 250 license plates, including annual renewals, are
12 issued for that distinctive license plate during any subsequent two-
13 year period after July 1, 2006.

14 (2) The director of vehicles shall discontinue the issuance of any
15 distinctive license plate authorized on and after July 1, 2004, if:

16 (A) Less than 500 plates, including annual renewals, are issued
17 for that distinctive license plate by the end of the second year of sales;
18 and

19 (B) less than 250 license plates, including annual renewals, are
20 issued for that distinctive license plate during any subsequent two-
21 year period.

22 (h) An application for any distinctive license plate issued after
23 December 31, 2012, and the corresponding royalty fee may be
24 collected either by the county treasurer or the entity benefiting from
25 the issuance of the distinctive license plate. Annual royalty payments
26 collected by the county treasurers shall be remitted to the state
27 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
28 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance the state
29 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the
30 credit of a segregated royalty fund which shall be administered by the
31 state treasurer. All expenditures from the royalty fund shall be made
32 in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director
33 of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the
34 state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the
35 royalty fund shall be made to the entity benefiting from the issuance of
36 the distinctive license plate on a monthly basis.

37 (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for any distinctive
38 license plate, the division shall produce such distinctive license plate
39 for a motorcycle upon request to the division by the organization
40 sponsoring the distinctive license plate.

41 (j) In addition to any residency requirements for all distinctive
42 license plates, any person not a resident of Kansas, serving as a
43 member of the armed forces stationed in this state shall be eligible to

1 apply for any distinctive license plate as if the individual was a
2 resident of this state. Such person shall be eligible to renew the
3 distinctive license plate registration as long as the person is still
4 stationed in this state at the time the registration is renewed.

5 {New Sec. 4. (a) On and after January 1, 2019, any owner or
6 lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a
7 gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas,
8 upon compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued one
9 city of Wichita license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck.
10 Such license plates shall be issued for the same time as other license
11 plates upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee
12 as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the
13 payment to the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment
14 established by the city of Wichita or the presentation of the annual
15 logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

16 (b) The city of Wichita may authorize the use of its flag image as
17 its logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any
18 royalty payment received pursuant to this section shall be used to
19 support physical assets identified by the Wichita parks foundation and
20 license plate administrative costs incurred by the Wichita parks
21 foundation. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee annually may apply to
22 the city of Wichita for the use of such logo. Upon annual application
23 and payment to either: (1) The city of Wichita in an amount of not less
24 than \$25 nor more than \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each
25 license plate to be issued, the city of Wichita shall issue to the motor
26 vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use
27 authorization statement, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle
28 owner or lessee at the time of registration; or (2) the county treasurer
29 of the logo use royalty payment for each license plate to be issued.

30 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section
31 may make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to
32 such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and
33 furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such
34 license plate shall either provide the annual logo use authorization
35 statement provided for in subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer
36 the logo use royalty payment established by the city of Wichita.
37 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and
38 issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the
39 owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles
40 upon forms furnished by the director.

41 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall
42 be transferable to any other person.

43 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer city of Wichita license

1 plates from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

2 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made
3 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the
4 manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No
5 renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such
6 applicant either provides to the county treasurer the annual logo use
7 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment
8 of the logo use royalty payment as established by the city of Wichita. If
9 such logo use authorization statement is not presented at the time of
10 registration or faxed by the city of Wichita, or the annual logo use
11 royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer at the time of
12 registration, the applicant shall be required to comply with K.S.A. 8-
13 143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the
14 county treasurer of such person's residence.

15 (g) The city of Wichita shall:

16 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates
17 authorized by this section; and

18 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
19 where applicants can call the city of Wichita for information
20 concerning the application process or the status of their license plate
21 application.

22 (h) The city of Wichita, with the approval of the director of
23 vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equipment,
24 shall design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

25 (i) As a condition of receiving the city of Wichita license plate and
26 any subsequent registration renewal of such plate, the applicant must
27 provide consent to the division authorizing the division's release of

29 address, logo use royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle
30 type to the city of Wichita and the state treasurer.

31 (j) Annual logo use royalty payments collected by county
32 treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in
33 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments
34 thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall
35 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the city
36 of Wichita royalty fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury
37 and shall be administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures from
38 the city of Wichita royalty fund shall be made in accordance with
39 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and
40 reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the state treasurer or
41 the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the city of Wichita
42 royalty fund to the appropriate designee of the city of Wichita shall be
43 made on a monthly basis. A change of the city's designee shall occur

1 only by mutual agreement of the city of Wichita and the Wichita parks
2 foundation.}

3 *New Sec. 5. (a) On and after January 1, 2019, any owner or lessee*
4 *of one or more passenger vehicles, trucks of a gross weight of 20,000*
5 *pounds or less or motorcycles, who is a resident of the state of Kansas,*
6 *and who submits satisfactory proof to the director of vehicles, in*
7 *accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the secretary of*
8 *revenue, that such person is a veteran of the Korean war, upon*
9 *compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued one*
10 *distinctive license plate for each such passenger vehicle, truck or*
11 *motorcycle designating such person as a veteran of the Korean war.*
12 *Such license plates shall be issued for the same period of time as other*
13 *license plates upon proper registration and payment of the regular*
14 *license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto.*

15 *(b) Any person who is a veteran of the Korean war may make*
16 *application for such distinctive license plates, not less than 60 days prior*
17 *to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and*
18 *furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for the*
19 *distinctive license plates shall furnish the director with proof as the*
20 *director shall require that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean war.*
21 *Application for the registration of a passenger vehicle, truck or*
22 *motorcycle and issuance of the license plates under this section shall be*
23 *made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of*
24 *vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.*

25 *(c) No registration or distinctive license plates issued under the*
26 *authority of this section shall be transferable to any other person.*

27 *(d) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made*
28 *annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the*
29 *manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No*

39 *accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the secretary of*
40 *revenue, that such person is a veteran of operation desert storm, upon*
41 *compliance with the provisions of this section, may be issued one*
42 *distinctive license plate for each such passenger vehicle, truck or*
43 *motorcycle designating such person as a veteran of operation desert*

1 *storm. Such license plates shall be issued for the same period of time as*
2 *other license plates upon proper registration and payment of the regular*
3 *license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto.*

4 *(b) Any person who is a veteran of operation desert storm may*
5 *make application for such distinctive license plates, not less than 60 days*
6 *prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed*
7 *and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for the*
8 *distinctive license plates shall furnish the director with proof as the*
9 *director shall require that the applicant is a veteran of operation desert*
10 *storm. Application for the registration of a passenger vehicle, truck or*
11 *motorcycle and issuance of the license plates under this section shall be*
12 *made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of*
13 *vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.*

14 *(c) No registration or distinctive license plates issued under the*
15 *authority of this section shall be transferable to any other person.*

16 *(d) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made*
17 *annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the*
18 *manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No*
19 *renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such*
20 *applicant has filed with the director a form as provided in subsection (b).*
21 *If such form is not filed, the applicant shall be required to comply with*

31 *distinctive license plate for each such passenger vehicle, truck or*
32 *motorcycle designating such person as a veteran of operation Iraqi*
33 *freedom. Such license plates shall be issued for the same period of time*
34 *as other license plates upon proper registration and payment of the*
35 *regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments*
36 *thereto.*

37 *(b) Any person who is a veteran of operation Iraqi freedom may*
38 *make application for such distinctive license plates, not less than 60 days*
39 *prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed*
40 *and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for the*
41 *distinctive license plates shall furnish the director with proof as the*
42 *director shall require that the applicant is a veteran of operation Iraqi*
43 *freedom. Application for the registration of a passenger vehicle, truck or*

1 *motorcycle and issuance of the license plates under this section shall be*
2 *made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of*
3 *vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.*

4 *(c) No registration or distinctive license plates issued under the*
5 *authority of this section shall be transferable to any other person.*

6 *(d) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made*
7 *annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the*
8 *manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No*
9 *renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such*
10 *applicant has filed with the director a form as provided in subsection (b).*
11 *If such form is not filed, the applicant shall be required to comply with*

21 *distinctive license plate for each such passenger vehicle, truck or*
22 *motorcycle designating such person as a veteran of operation enduring*
23 *freedom. Such license plates shall be issued for the same period of time*
24 *as other license plates upon proper registration and payment of the*
25 *regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments*
26 *thereto.*

27 *(b) Any person who is a veteran of operation enduring freedom*
28 *may make application for such distinctive license plates, not less than 60*
29 *days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form*
30 *prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant*
31 *for the distinctive license plates shall furnish the director with proof as*
32 *the director shall require that the applicant is a veteran of operation*
33 *enduring freedom. Application for the registration of a passenger*
34 *vehicle, truck or motorcycle and issuance of the license plates under this*
35 *section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by*
36 *the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.*

37 *(c) No registration or distinctive license plates issued under the*
38 *authority of this section shall be transferable to any other person.*

39 *(d) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made*
40 *annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the*
41 *manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No*
42 *renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such*
43 *applicant has filed with the director a form as provided in subsection (b).*

1 *If such form is not filed, the applicant shall be required to comply with*
2 *K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the distinctive license*
3 *plates to the county treasurer of such person's residence.*

4 *Sec. 9. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 8-1,147 is hereby amended to read as*
5 *follows: 8-1,147. In the event of the death of any person issued*
