1 AN ACT concerning the judicial branch; relating to docket fees;
2 disposition of docket fees for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2020, and
3 June 30, 2021; amending K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 20-362 and repealing the
4 existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 20-362 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 20-362. The clerk of the district court shall remit all revenues
9 received from docket fees as follows:

10 (a) At least monthly to the county treasurer, for deposit in the county
11 treasury and credit to the county general fund:

12 (1) A sum equal to \$10 for each docket fee paid pursuant to K.S.A.
13 60-2001 and 60-3005, and amendments thereto, during the preceding
14 calendar month;

15 (2) a sum equal to \$10 for each \$46 or \$76 docket fee paid pursuant
16 to K.S.A. 61-4001, or K.S.A. 61-2704 or 61-2709, and amendments
17 thereto; and

18 (3) a sum equal to \$5 for each \$26 docket fee paid pursuant to K.S.A.
19 61-4001 or K.S.A. 61-2704, and amendments thereto, during the preceding
20 calendar month.

21 (b) At least monthly to the board of trustees of the county law library
22 fund, for deposit in the fund, a sum equal to the library fees paid during the
23 preceding calendar month for cases filed in the county.

24 (c) At least monthly to the county treasurer, for deposit in the county
25 treasury and credit to the prosecuting attorneys' training fund, a sum equal
26 to \$2 for each docket fee paid pursuant to K.S.A. 28-172a, and
27 amendments thereto, during the preceding calendar month for cases filed
28 in the county and a sum equal to \$1 for each fee paid pursuant to K.S.A.
29 28-170(c), and amendments thereto, during the preceding calendar month
30 for cases filed in the county.

31 (d) To the state treasurer, in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A.
32 75-4215, and amendments thereto, for deposit in the state treasury and
33 credit to the law enforcement training center fund a sum equal to \$15 for
34 each docket fee paid pursuant to K.S.A. 28-172a, and amendments thereto,
35 during the preceding calendar month.

36 (e) To the state treasurer, in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A.

1 75-4215, and amendments thereto, for deposit in the state treasury a sum
2 equal to the balance which remains from all docket fees paid during the
3 preceding calendar month after deduction of the amounts specified in
4 subsections (a), (b), (c) and (d). Of the balance remitted to the state
5 treasury pursuant to this subsection, the state treasurer shall credit 0.99%
6 to the judicial council fund. During the fiscal years ending ~~June 30, 2015,~~
7 ~~June 30, 2016, June 30, 2017,~~ June 30, 2018, ~~and~~ June 30, 2019, *June 30,*
8 *2020, and June 30, 2021,* of the remainder, the state treasurer shall deposit
9 and credit the first \$3,100,000 to the electronic filing and management
10 fund created in K.S.A. 2017 Supp. ~~20-1a16~~ *20-1a20*, and amendments
11 thereto. During the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2020~~ *2022*, and each fiscal
12 year thereafter, of the remainder, the state treasurer shall deposit and credit
13 the first ~~\$1,000,000~~ *\$1,500,000* to the electronic filing and management
14 fund. Of the balance which remains after deduction of the amounts
15 specified in this subsection, the state treasurer shall deposit and credit the
16 remainder to the judicial branch docket fee fund.

17 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 20-362 is hereby repealed.

18 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
19 publication in the statute book.
