SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2192

As Recommended by House Committee on
Agriculture

Brief*

HB 2192 would change the name of “Lake Scott State Park” to “Historic Lake Scott State Park.”

Background

The bill was introduced in the House Committee on Agriculture at the request of the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWPT). In the House Committee hearing, Representative Hineman and a representative of KDWPT testified in favor of the bill. The two proponents provided a brief overview of the park’s unique cultural and geologic history. The KDWPT representative, in oral testimony, stated the name change would assist with the marketability of the park. No other testimony was provided.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget, KDWPT states the bill would require the agency to change signage and publications, but stated these changes would be made as part of their regular maintenance and have no fiscal effect on the agency.
