Mr. Chairman and members of the committee:

It's my pleasure to support the passage of **HB 2044**, which provides tax credits for those who purchase from vendors that provide employment opportunities for individuals with disabilities. Returning members may remember this bill from last term as **HB 2416**, which ultimately passed the full House 122-0, but languished in the Senate.

Dynamic economic modeling of HB 2044 would show a net positive fiscal impact. Increased sales for the vendors means additional employment opportunities, plus health insurance benefits, for disabled individuals. The intent is to turn tax consumers into tax payers, and eliminate the necessity for a Medicaid waiver. That alone would save the state more than the tax credit offered.
