Honorable Senate and House Members KS. State House, Topeka, KS 66612

Durham School Services is pleased to voice our support for HB 2315 and urge its prompt passage by the Legislature. The bill would address the unfairness in current law which prevents school bus drivers from applying for unemployment benefits when the schools they serve are not in session.

Given the critical role that a stable, experienced workforce plays in assuring safe student transportation, we view it as both prudent and safety conscious to allow contracted school bus drivers to claim unemployment benefits during the summer months. In particular, we believe bill will advance sound public policy for a number of key reasons:

- Safety and Stability. Contracted school bus drivers who are able to claim unemployment
 benefits will more likely return to work as bus drivers during the school year, helping assure the
 seamless continuation of a safe, reliable, and well-trained driver workforce. This translates in
 greater student safety as drivers play a critical role in assuring that students arrive at school
 safe, on-time, and ready to learn.
- Unemployment Insurance Already Paid. Durham School Services already pays unemployment
 insurance and recognizes that its contributions to the system will increase should SB 38 pass and
 enable contracted bus drivers to claim unemployment benefits. We believe that our contracted
 drivers should receive the benefit of the contributions we make to the system.
- Fairness and Seasonality. School bus drivers who claim unemployment benefits do so because
 they have no other employment options during the summer months. Some drivers do find
 other seasonal work, but for others, there is simply no option. Durham believes that it is unfair
 that some individuals who find themselves without work through no fault of their own are
 allowed to claim unemployment benefits while others are not.
