Dear Education Committee Members,

I am writing in support Chairman Huebert's proposed amendments HB 2601.

I believe it is reasonable and logical the KDHE has increased oversight on the mandating of vaccines. KDHE partners with industries directly receiving financial benefit from vaccines. Our representatives REPRESENT for the people of Kansas.
