Subject: Bill Brief for HB 2083

HB 2083 amends K.S.A. 40-1112a, pertaining to the required reduction in auto insurance premium charges when an individual successfully completes a motor vehicle accident safety course. The bill establishes a four-hour minimum duration for the course. The bill also replaces the phrase "governmental agency" with "state or federal agency" and also strikes the language "such as the state board of education."

The bill contains some technical fixes to improve readability and would become effective on July 1, 2019.
