Subject: Senate Bill No. 125

Summary

Senate Bill No. 125 extends the eligible time periods for the rural opportunity zone student loan

repayment program and the income tax credit.

Section 1 amends K.S.A. 74-50,223 to extend the eligible time period for the rural opportunity

zone student loan repayment program for five more years, from the current date of June 30, 2021,

to June 30, 2026. In order to be eligible, a resident individual would need to establish domicile in

a participating rural opportunity zone county on or after the date in which the county started

participation, and prior to July 1, 2026.

Section 2 amends K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 79-32,267 to extend the rural opportunity zone income tax

credit for five more years, from its current end with tax year 2021 to tax year 2026. In order to be

eligible for the tax credit, the resident individual would need to establish domicile in a rural

opportunity zone on or after July 1, 2011, and prior to January 1, 2026, in addition to the other

requirements.

Section 4 provides that the act shall take effect from and after its publication in the statute book.
