Thank you for your time in allowing me to express my opposition to SB 294. The bill as currently written seems to be expensive, confusing and difficult to implement. Using current year values with the prior year mill levy doesn't seem to be a very accurate figure to present to a taxpayer.

Each entity currently publishes the date and time for the public hearing of the budget so taxpayers can voice concerns and questions. They get very little or no feedback at these hearings. Sending a notice to each taxpayer, at the cost of the entity, would create a financial burden to the entity and would be time consuming for our office. Not to mention trying to coordinate hearings with districts that cross county lines without overlapping the hearings.

Dickinson County has 146 taxing units. One township alone has 13 tax units and each tax unit is different. Example:
