Testimony of Jeremy Cook, MD Senate Public Health and Welfare Committee Oral Proponent Regarding SB 223

Mr. Chair and members of the Committee. Thank you for allowing us to speak to you today in support of SB 223 which will authorize and license a new health care provider in KS to assist physician anesthesiologists. The provider would be known as a certified Anesthesiologist Assistant (CAA).

I am a physician anesthesiologist practicing in Kansas City, Kansas. I also help teach the next generation of doctors for our state.

To briefly summarize events that have occurred before this hearing today, KSA and the Kansas Medical Society (KMS) introduced CAA licensure legislation during the 2017 legislative session. At that time, concerns were raised that the KDHE Credentialing of Health Care Personnel process had not been completed. As a result, we were instructed to complete the KDHE credentialing process and it was also requested that KSA meet with the Kansas Association of Nurse Anesthetists (KANA) and attempt to reach a compromise on the issue. A meeting was subsequently held where both sides had the opportunity to discuss their respective positions. After that meeting it was reported to us that the KANA board voted to suspend any further discussions with KSA related to CAA licensure.

KSA along with representatives of the CAA community filed an application with KDHE to begin the credentialing process on September 1, 2017, and that process was finally completed in December, 2018. The KDHE Technical Review Committee, after a series of meetings which included the opportunity to hear from both proponents and opponents of the issue, determined that all nine criteria for provider credentialing had been met, and voted to approve the application for credentialing of CAAs in Kansas. Attached to my testimony is a list of all of the proponents who took the time to write letters of support or appear in front of the committee requesting licensure of CAAs. The technical review committee recommended on their report that the CAAs credentialing application be approved and the provider be licensed by the state. That report was forwarded to the Secretary of KDHE and after review by the new Secretary of KDHE, the report was signed and finally presented to the Legislature in February, 2019. We then had a hearing in the House Health Committee on February 18 on HB 2295 which is very similar to SB 223. That bill has been blessed and may have action taken on it in the House before the end of the Session and we are now before you today for consideration of SB 223.

During testimony today you will hear from physician anesthesiologists with significant long-term experience practicing with CAAs in an anesthesia care team model. They are familiar with the education, training and quality, safe care CAA's provide. You will also hear from other anesthesiolgists in Kansas whose practices are experiencing severe provider shortages and are desperately seeking an additional provider pool to fill those needs and continue to provide access to safe anesthesia care for their patients. You will also hear from a CAA who would like the opportunity to work in the state they live in and call home, Kansas.

On behalf of the Kansas Society of Anesthesiologists, we respectfully request your passage of SB 223 which will allow CAA's to work in Kansas and improve access to care for Kansas citizens.
