Subject: SB 210-Providing KPERS membership to certain direct support positions in community developmental disability organizations upon completion of a two-year training period.

Senate Bill No. 210 provides that an employee in a direct support position of a community developmental disability organization established and organized by a county or counties under K.S.A. 19-4001 becomes a member of KPERS on the first day of the payroll period coinciding with or following the completion of a two-year training period, whichever is later.

Under current law an employee in such a position becomes a KPERS member on the first day of employment with a participating community developmental disability organization.
