MR. CHAIRMAN:

I move to amend **House Substitute for SB 102**, on page 1, in line 7, after the comma by inserting "during any state of disaster emergency pursuant to K.S.A. 48-924, and amendments thereto,"; in line 12, after the comma by inserting "during any state of disaster emergency pursuant to K.S.A. 48-924, and amendments thereto,"; in line 17, after "(c)" by inserting "Any order issued pursuant to this section may remain in effect for up to 150 days after a state of disaster emergency is terminated pursuant to K.S.A. 48-924, and amendments thereto. Any order in violation of this section shall be void.

(d)";

On page 3, in line 25, by striking all after "section"; by striking all in line 26; in line 27, by striking all before the period and inserting "pursuant to section 1, and amendments thereto. When an order issued pursuant to section 1, and amendments thereto, is terminated, any trial scheduled to occur during the time such order was in effect shall be placed back on the court schedule within 150 days";

On page 5, in line 16, by striking all after "section"; by striking all in line 17; in line 18, by striking all before the period and inserting "pursuant to section 1, and amendments thereto"
