SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2135 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2135 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2135 would repeal KSA 2018 Supp. 25-2711 which provides that no city or county can regulate or prohibit the placement of or the number of political signs on private property or the unpaved right-of-way for city streets or county roads on private property during the 45-day period prior to any election and the two-day period following the same election.

League of Kansas Municipalities and the Association of Counties indicate enactment of HB 2135 would have no fiscal effect on city or county governments.
